Window Period: Thursday, 12 December -Friday, 31 January 2024

A longer window period to allow us to choose an appropriately nuking day

Event Duration: One day within the window period

Alerts: 48-hour Yellow Light call, followed by a 24-hour Green Light call

Location: High Five \neq 66 and 68 Beach Boulevard, Blouberg, Cape Town

Athletes: 16 riders - open to women and men of all ages

STRUCTURE OF EVENT:

CONDITIONS AND RIDING

- 16 Riders
- 5 Rounds, total competition time of 3 hours and 17 minutes
- Competition will only run when the conditions are suitable, being a minimum of 30 knots of wind for the entire duration of the competition.
- Shorts lines are classified as anything 14m or less.
- · This competition is about extremity

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Extremity is the wow factor in short lines riding, therefore, the judging will be swayed heavily towards that.
- Judging of a trick will be weighted 30% height, 70% extremity.
- Variety score will make up 25% of the total score.
- Top three tricks will be counted towards the total score
- We will have a riders meeting to clarify and discuss.

In this form, you will be asked to upload a video link (URL to Instagram or YouTube) of your short lines riding.

The video does not have to be specifically made for the competition, but a compilation of clips would be best to better showcase your skills.
